The 2008-09 Youth Basketball season is set to begin on Saturday, January 10, 2009. All league schedules can be downloaded from our website in addition to viewing league standings, reschedules, and other important information. The City currently has 95 teams playing in eight different divisions ranging from 6-18 years of age.



Games are scheduled Monday-Saturday, with most teams playing twice per week. A single elimination tournament for all leagues age 9 and up will be scheduled following the conclusion of the regular season.
